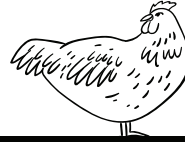
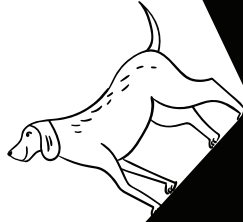

**Smaller ones** - under 1.5 meters high/wide to be displayed at the hall

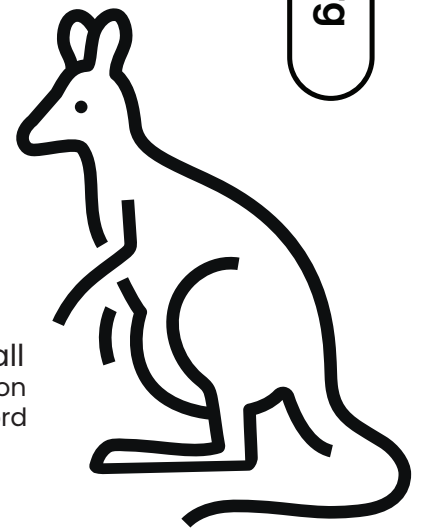
The three prizes are across the whole competition so it doesn't matter which option you enter with you'll have the same chance at winning so long as we have a record of your entry for our judge to view.
